(Please carry this card with you at all times)

A missing child is every parent's worst nightmare and most would like to believe that such an occurrence could never happen to them.

In a panic situation such as being separated from your child in a busy mall or public area, this card can dramatically facilitate the search as you may be too traumatized to be able to correctly describe your child. We encourage you to:

1. Carry this card (complete with a recent, quality photograph of your child, as well as a description of his / her vital statistics) with you at all times.
2. Update this information every six months because children grow and change quickly!

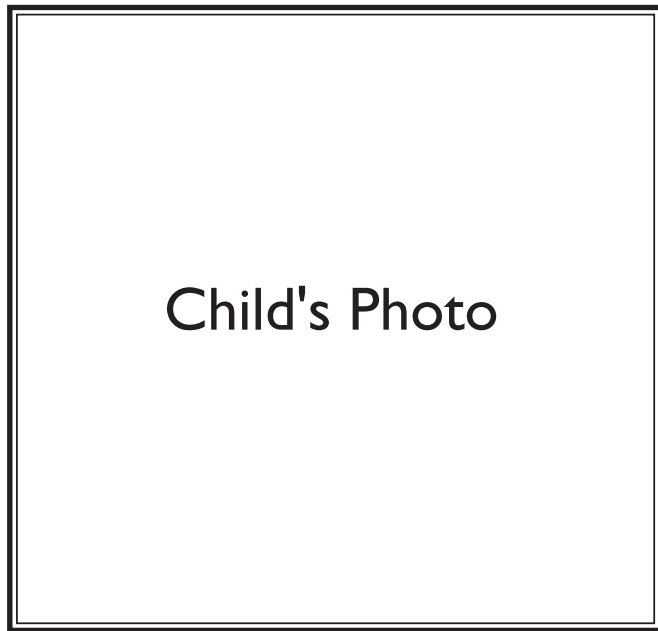
